# 5 TIPS TO HELP YOU CHOOSE YOUR 2025 HEALTH BENEFITS

As millions of Americans evaluate their health plan options during this fall's open enrollment season, a new survey finds that 3 in 5 Americans incorrectly defined key health care terms. This knowledge gap may result in less-than-ideal selections, which could cause you to miss out on plans that might better suit your needs and offer potential cost savings.

**Enrollment timing:** For people with coverage from their employer, open enrollment typically happens during a two- or three-week period between September and December. For those eligible for Medicare, the Medicare Annual Enrollment Period runs from Oct. 15 to Dec. 7 each year. For people shopping for individual plans on the Health Insurance Marketplace, open enrollment begins Nov. 1, 2024, and ends Jan. 15, 2025, in most states.

**1. Plan ahead.** Take time to understand the benefits, services and costs of plans available - including what might have changed with your current coverage. Pay attention to more than just the monthly premium, also understanding what out-of-pocket costs like deductibles, copays and

coinsurance you may be responsible for. Resources like JustPlainClear.com and MedicareMadeClear.com can provide valuable assistance.

**Medicare members and caregivers:** As you weigh your options, assess the differences between Original Medicare and Medicare Advantage. Visit MedicareEducation.com to find answers to questions about eligibility, plan choices, prescription coverage and more.

**2. Help prevent unexpected costs.** Check if your doctor is in your plan's provider network, since visiting in-network providers can help reduce out-of-pocket costs. Make sure your medications will be covered next year by the plan you choose. And consider filling your prescriptions at an in-network pharmacy or with home delivery - more cost-efficient options.

**Medicare members and caregivers:** Original Medicare doesn't generally cover prescription drugs. Consider enrolling in a Medicare Advantage plan with prescription drug coverage to help keep medication costs in check.

**3. Explore mental health coverage.** Beyond in-person mental health care, you may have access to a virtual network of therapists and psychiatrists, along with advocates to help find

the right behavioral health care or resources.

**Medicare members and caregivers:** Look for plans that offer virtual mental health care with a \$0 copay.

**4. Look into specialty benefits.** Additional benefits, such as dental, vision, hearing or critical illness insurance, are often available and may contribute to overall well-being.

**Medicare members and caregivers:** Original Medicare doesn't cover most dental, vision and hearing services, but many Medicare Advantage plans do.

**5. Consider wellness programs.** Many health plans offer incentives for taking healthier actions, like completing a health survey or exercising. Others provide personalized support to those living with common chronic conditions like Type 2 diabetes.

**Medicare members and caregivers:** Many Medicare Advantage plans offer gym memberships and wellness programs for members at no additional cost.

## RED CROSS REMINDER: CHECK SMOKE ALARMS WHEN TURNING CLOCKS BACK

Daylight Saving Time ends this weekend and when everyone turns their clocks back, the American Red Cross reminds them to also take these steps to make sure their household is prepared for emergencies.

"It's important for everyone to make sure their household is ready," said Tony Briggs, Communications Director, American Red Cross Desert to the Sea Region. "A disaster like a home fire can happen anywhere, at any time. We urge people to take these steps now and know what they should do if an emergency occurs."

**Check smoke alarm batteries.** When turning the clocks ahead, take a few minutes to replace the smoke alarm batteries and push the test button to make sure the alarms are working. It's also a great time to check carbon monoxide detectors.

**Install smoke alarms.** If someone doesn't have smoke alarms, install them. At a minimum, put one on every level of the home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas. Check local building codes for additional requirements.

**Practice an escape plan.** Make sure everyone in the family knows how to get out of every room and how to get out of the home in less than two minutes.

Get a kit. Keep disaster supplies in an

easy-to-carry bag to use at home or carry in case ordered to evacuate.

**Make a plan.** Have all household members plan what steps they should take if an emergency occurs.

**Be informed.** Learn what emergencies can occur in the area and how officials notify residents should a disaster occur.

**Red Cross Apps:** People can download the all-inclusive Red Cross Emergency app which combines more than 35 emergency alerts to help keep the user safe. And there is a special mobile app - Monster Guard - designed for kids, teaching them to prepare for emergencies at home by playing an engaging game. Users can find the apps in smartphone app stores by searching for the American Red Cross or going to [redcross.org/apps](http://redcross.org/apps).

**Home Fire Campaign:** Seven times a day someone in this country dies in a fire. The Red Cross has been working to reduce that number through its Home Fire Campaign, a multi-year effort to reduce the number of home fire deaths and injuries by 25 percent. Launched in October of 2014, the Red Cross and thousands of campaign partners have installed more than one million smoke alarms nationally. Here in the Desert to the Sea region, the Red Cross has installed more than 12,000 smoke



alarms in Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties.

**What people can do:** People can visit [redcross.org/homefires](http://redcross.org/homefires) to find out more about how to protect themselves and their loved homes from fire. They can become a Red Cross volunteer by going to [redcross.org/volunteer](http://redcross.org/volunteer). They can also help by donating to Red Cross Disaster Relief by visiting [redcross.org](http://redcross.org), calling 1-800-RED CROSS or texting the word REDCROSS to 90999 to make a \$10 donation. Donations to Disaster Relief will be used to prepare for, respond to and help people recover

from disasters big and small.

# FALL BACK DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME ENDS THIS SUNDAY

When does the time change for Fall 2024? That time change question seems to be something that a lot of people are asking themselves. For this year, 2024, the time change will occur on Sunday, November 3, 2024 at 2 a.m. Eastern Standard Time. And remember for the time change 2024 this fall you will “fall back”, or move your clocks back one hour and gain some much needed sleep.

It is easy to remember which way to move your clocks if you follow the old adage of, in the spring you “Spring forward” and in the fall you “Fall back”. It is nice during the time change for fall 2024 that you get to gain an hour of sleep. According to many studies most of us don’t sleep enough, so this extra hour will be welcomed.

Remember that the way this whole time change thing is setup is as follows: At 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March each year, we set our clocks forward one hour ahead of Standard Time (“Spring forward”). Then at 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in November each year we “Fall back” and we set our clocks back one hour and this returns us to Standard Time.

Daylight Saving Time was actually put in place during World War I in the United States as a way to save energy for the war production. By changing the time it made for longer days between April and October. Then again during World War II the government required the states to perform the instituted time change. But then after the wars the states were free to choose whether or not they wanted to institute the Daylight Savings time or not.

But by 1966, Congress got involved and passed the Uniform Time Act, which then dictated the length of Daylight Saving




Time. These longer days do mean that we use less energy as a country in lighting our homes and businesses.

In 2005, Congress came along again and passed the Energy Policy Act. That started that starting in 2007 that Daylight Saving Time would be four weeks longer. The thought process was that we would be able to save approximately 10,000 barrels of oil each day through reducing

power requirements of businesses. But that is a very difficult metric to verify and to know if we are seeing the savings that was projected.

So, when does the time change for fall 2024? Just remember that on Sunday, November 3, 2024 at 2 a.m. Eastern Standard Time you will set your clocks back one hour. Enjoy your extra hour of sleep!

**Grape and Brussels Sprout Slaw**

Servings: 6

- 1 bag (12 ounces) shredded Brussels sprouts
- 2/3 cup finely shredded red cabbage
- 2 cups red Grapes from California, halved lengthwise
- 1/2 cup finely diced red onion
- 3 scallions, trimmed and thinly sliced
- 2 tablespoons rice vinegar

- 1 1/2 tablespoons honey
- 1 teaspoon fresh lemon or lime juice
- 1 teaspoon low-sodium soy sauce
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon toasted (dark) sesame oil
- freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 3 tablespoons toasted sesame seeds

In large mixing bowl, combine shredded sprouts, cabbage, grapes, onion and scallions.

In small bowl, whisk vinegar, honey, lemon or lime juice and soy sauce. Drizzle in olive and sesame oils while whisking. Toss well with slaw mixture. Chill 45 minutes to incorporate flavors. Season with pepper and sprinkle sesame seeds on top.

2,000 miles. Such extensive travel plans highlight the need for dependable vehicles and robust tires to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip.

Long-distance travel requires careful planning and preparation. Travelers should consider the reliability of their vehicles, the condition of their tires, and the overall readiness of their cars for extended periods on the road. Ensuring that the vehicle is in top condition can prevent breakdowns and delays, allowing for a smoother journey. Additionally, planning for rest stops, overnight stays, and route options can enhance the travel experience, making long distances more manageable and enjoyable.

### Choosing the right ride

The preference for practicality is particularly pronounced among Boomers, with 71% favoring more sensible vehicles. This trend suggests that for many travelers, reliability and comfort may outweigh the allure of a more entertaining or stylish ride.

### Focus on durable tires

Part of ensuring a safe and enjoyable journey is making sure your vehicle is road-trip ready, and that includes having the correct tires. Durability in tires is crucial for long-distance travel, where



road conditions can vary significantly. The Gauge Index reveals that when purchasing tires, Americans prioritize durability, with 30% indicating it as their primary consideration. Durable tires offer better resistance to wear and tear, providing a safer and more reliable driving experience. Price follows closely behind at 22%, while performance comes in third at 20%. The focus on price and performance also highlights the importance of finding a balance between cost-effectiveness and quality. By investing in high-quality tires, travelers can reduce the risk of issues on the road and enjoy a smoother ride.

### Tire maintenance habits

Regular tire maintenance is crucial for road safety and optimal vehicle performance, and that is especially

important before heading out for a long distance drive. However, the Gauge Index found only 47% of drivers check their tire pressure regularly, and only 28% check their tread regularly. # Taste of Wine & Food

## DEL MAR WINE AND FOOD FESTIVAL SOARS IN SECOND YEAR

The second Del Mar Wine + Food Festival was a huge success, surpassing its impressive debut. San Diego native and Food Network star Troy Johnson, known for his role as a lead judge on Guy's Grocery Games, set a high standard with last year's event and exceeded expectations this year. The six-day festival featured immersive culinary experiences and sold-out dinners across San Diego, concluding with a two-day Grand Tasting. The lineup included top local chefs, Food Network and Top Chef favorites, and sports stars like Drew Brees, Drew Morgan, and Rob Machado. The event also raised funds for Feeding San Diego, continuing last year's tradition, which generated \$25,000 for the hunger relief organization.

In addition to The Grand Tasting, Frank and I attended a seminar called, A Perfect Wine, led by Ted Glennon, the curator and sommelier for the entire festival. Glennon, a 6th-generation Californian who transitioned from a top sommelier to a winemaker with Vinos Finos de California, brought his extensive festival experience to San Diego, ensuring the seminar's engaging atmosphere. Attendees blind-tasted wines and shared their impressions, which were transformed into a crowd-sourced word cloud, followed by scoring each wine.

The panel featured legendary winemaker David Ramey, known for pioneering modern American winemaking techniques and affectionately called "Professor Chardonnay" by Wine Spectator. Ramey, who has shaped California winemaking since the 1970s, provided invaluable insights into what

makes a wine truly great. Joining him were Jonathan Cristaldi, Napa Valley correspondent and critic for Decanter magazine and Editor-at-Large for The SOMM Journal, and Femi Oyediran, co-owner of Graft Wine Shop and Wine Bar in Charleston. Oyediran, recognized as Food & Wine Magazine's 2019 'Sommelier of the Year,' brought a fresh, relatable perspective to the discussion. The panelists each defended their scores and offered their expert analysis, creating a lively and educational debate. The highest-rated wine of the seminar was a 2021 Paul Hobbs Coombsville Cabernet Sauvignon. This engaging seminar was a highlight of the festival for me.

The Grand Tasting was the big event of the festival featuring over 100 wineries and beer/kombucha breweries, mostly representing California. Additionally, there were about 100 restaurants in the general admission and high end VIP sections. Both the wine and food were exceptional.

On our way to the VIP pavilion, we encountered Chef Dominic Cagliero of Full Send BBQ, who was serving up melt-in-your-mouth brisket. The brisket was incredibly flavorful and so tender, it almost seemed to melt like liquid. As Frank put it, "I want to have this at my funeral." For those in the Carson, CA area, you're lucky to have Full Send BBQ nearby. Just across from Full Send was Tanner's Prime Burgers. Last year, I learned their only location was at Del Mar Racetrack, but now they have opened a new store in Oceanside. North County San Diego burger fans, you're in for a treat!

After enjoying our beef delicacies, we made our way to the VIP pavilion, stopping by some of our Paso Robles favorites: Austin Hope, Booker, DAOU, and J. Lohr. At the Austin Hope booth, CJ and Kylie poured tastings of Grenache, Malbec, Cab Franc, and Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, which is aged for 30 months—15 months in 50% new French oak, followed by 15 months in once-used French oak. Carson and Anela served Perl (91% Syrah, 9% Grenache) and Cublie (56% Grenache, 24% Syrah, 20% Mourvèdre) at the Booker booth. DAOU's Eryn Schnitzler offered tastes of Sauvignon Blanc, Rosé, Reserve Cab Sauvignon, and the Pessimist Red Blend. J. Lohr showcased Arroyo Vista Chardonnay and Fog's Reach Pinot Noir from their Monterey vineyards, as well as Hilltop Cab Sauvignon and Pure Paso from Paso Robles vineyards.

The VIP pavilion food tastings were exquisite. Fairmont Grand Del Mar Amaya's Executive Chef Bryn McArthur and Chef de Cuisine Roman Garcia served a Croque Madame with ham hock, comté espuma, brioche, and cured

ham in an egg shell for sustainability. The standout of the day was The Marine Room Executive Chef Michael Vaughn's Savory Charcoal Macaron, featuring cold-smoked beet-cured Scottish salmon, Twarog cheese, lemon verbena, anise hyssop, and ikura, topped with 23-karat gold caviar.

My favorite wine booth of the day was Napa Valley's Ramey Wine Cellars, where Jeff Boyer, Western US Sales Manager, treated guests to a tasting of the 2021 Fort Ross Chardonnay, 2017 Roger's Creek Syrah, 2019 Claret red blend, and a Pedregal Cab Sauvignon vertical featuring 2013, 2014, and 2017 vintages. The Fort Ross Chardonnay offered bright minerality from its high-elevation vineyard. The Syrah, grown in the fog-covered Petaluma Gap, delivered savory smoked meat and white pepper notes. The Bordeaux-

based Claret blended Cab Sauvignon with Syrah, Malbec, Petit Verdot, Merlot, and a touch of Cab Franc. The Pedregal vertical was a standout, showcasing concentrated Cab Sauvignon fruit from the rocky soils of Oakville's eastern hillside, where neighbors include Screaming Eagle, Tench, and Tierra Roja vineyards. Thank you, Jeff, for this exceptional tasting experience!

After the VIP tent, we stopped by the Amalfi Cucina booth for some Neapolitan pizza, as well as, visiting a few Temecula Valley booths including Falkner Winery and Cougar Winery.

Congrats to Troy Johnson, Ted Glennon, and the rest of the team that created a 2nd year wine and food festival that keeps getting better and for supporting Feed San Diego! More info at delmar.wine.
